## **#1 Freshwater Policy General Update**

Presented by Taylor Farr & Naomi Crawford, Waikato Regional Council (a copy of the presentation is attached). Additional points noted:

 National Policy Statement for Freshwater Management – WRC awaiting direction from the Court on which parts will be operative. To date there have been no significant changes proposed in the Waikato Regional Plan for forestry – it is likely to remain under the NES-CF regs.  National Policy Statement for Indigenous Biodiversity – the Government has signalled its intent to review the SNA criteria, mainly in response to feedback from farming. This could have implications for forestry.

## #2 Compliance/ Regulatory Update

Presented by Perry Empson, Waikato Regional Council (a copy of the presentation is attached).

The committee discussed management of slash. Some companies are seeking consent for slash management under the new rules. Perry noted the main assessment is the stability of the ground where slash is being left.

# **#3 Wildling Conifer Control**

Presented by Clark McMichael, Waikato Regional Council (a copy is attached). Clark noted:

- WRC is unlikely to have Central Government funding going forward as it has been significantly reduced, and WRC has provided some funding to continue at a reduced rate.
- Coming to grips with the Wildling Conifer situation in Waikato, Taipo and Turangi.
- Using high resolution satellites to identify and quantify issues.
